In 2025, we successfully achieved our goal of supporting more than 20 babies every month. It is a great joy for us to celebrate the birth of so many children. Notably, about 30% of the babies we support are battling severe illnesses. We packed each basket with prayers for their swift recovery and discharge. We have also begun sharing feedback from families who received the baskets on Instagram (with their permission), which has helped more people discover the existence of UL316. We will continue to advocate for the dignity of people with Down syndrome until society becomes a place that warmly embraces all babies born with disabilities.



## Activity Reports for 2025



**Sports Event (August):** We held a sports event for children aged 4 to elementary school age and their siblings. The program was designed to be slow-paced, considering the children's muscle hypotonia and their anxiety toward new places and people, creating a heartwarming time for parents and children to move together. We also had a time of reading of "Sei-chan's Picture Book" to emphasize on God's love to everyone.



**Inclusive Parenting Space:** We held a monthly inclusive gathering for babies and preschoolers. A certified volunteer taught baby massage, providing a relaxing environment for both mothers and children regardless of whether they have a disability.

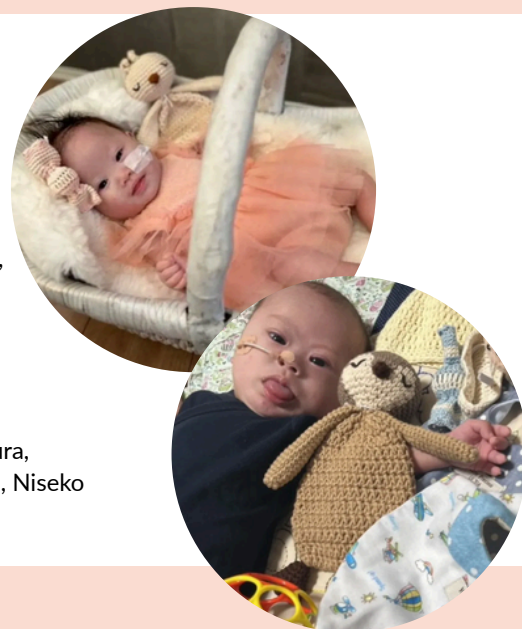

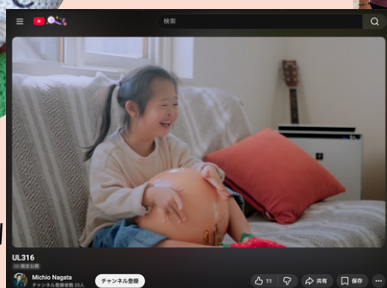


Condolences: We remember Mr. Takao Harada, an amigurumi artist who passed away. We will continue his legacy and the project in his honor.
